Grants of up to \$10,000 are available for:

- Social and emotional wellbeing support
- Keeping communities connected
- Responding to immediate needs
- Advocacy and information

HOW MUCH CAN I APPLY FOR?

Applicants can apply for grants from \$1,000 to \$10,000.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Aboriginal run or controlled groups and organisations located in NSW.

IMPORTANT DATES

Program re-opens on **14 February 2022** and closes at **5pm** on **29 April 2022**.

Applications will be accepted at any time during the opening period. The assessment panel will meet weekly to approve applications and release funding.

Projects must be implemented by recipients within three months of funding being received.

PROGRAM CHANGES

There have been some changes to project eligibility, this includes funding eligibility for one off food relief rather than food insecurity. We encourage you to review the guidelines before applying.
