We are writing to request your active participation in the events that will be held in the Moreton Bay Region during the upcoming 2022 Child Protection Week (CPW).

The Moreton Bay Child and Family Network (MBCFN) in collaboration with the Moreton Bay Local Level Alliance (MBLLA) is once again hosting community activities across the region to raise awareness that child protection is everybody's business.

In Person Events

Targeting four primary schools from different corners of the region; our event gives parents the opportunity to participate in child protective strategies information and education workshops alongside industry experts. The workshops will promote child safety, by providing parents with resources and connecting children and families with appropriate local supports in a non-threatening environment. Parents who attend the workshops will be provided with CPW activity packs; that will include child safe activities that can be completed by children with parents/carers/guardians. Each pack provides children with age and stage appropriate child safe books promoting protective strategies. The CPW packs are designed to enhance protective strategies within the family unit by promoting quality time, creative exploration, health and nutrition, self-care and literacy.

Online Events

Families in Moreton Bay will also be able to connect to Child Protection Week by taking part in a virtual art competition focusing on the CPW theme *Protecting Children is Everybody's Business*. Photos of submissions will be shared to a social media page with the winning artwork announced online. Along with the art component of the online awareness campaign, parents will be offered virtual workshops to promote children and young people's safety. This will ensure education and awareness is discussed through the different stages of childhood and adolescence. Having online workshops allows parents/carers/guardians outside of these 4 school communities to be involved and supported.



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We are calling for local community organisations, Government agencies and local businesses that assist children and families in the Moreton Bay Community. We would like to invite providers who focus on children, young people and families, interested in child protection to express their interest.

Your opportunity is to engage in one or several of the below options:

- Donate *pre-packed activity pack (with instructions) to be distributed to families of students at the selected 4 primary schools.
- Create a fun and engaging video tutorial on how to do an activity at home. This activity should either relate to the activity pack you're donating OR involve using readily accessible materials.
- Facilitate a virtual workshop to promote children or young people's safety.
